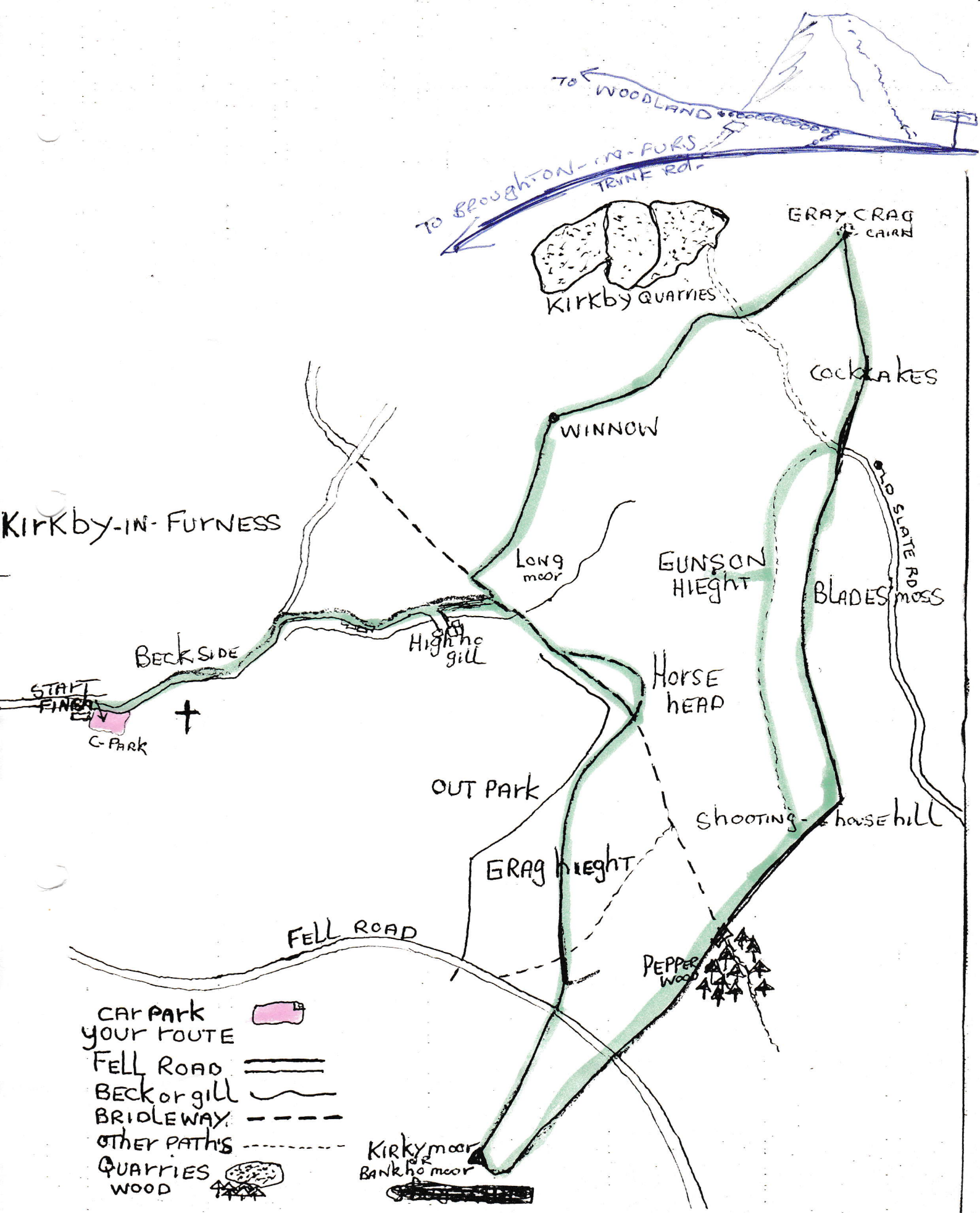

ON LEAVING THE COMMUNITY CENTRE CAR PARK TURN RIGHT: "WALK THROUGH THE VILLAGE WITH THE CHURCH ON YOUR RIGHTHAND SIDE WHEN YOU REACH THE NARROW'S LOOK STRAIT AHEAD" "A SLEEP HILL THAT'S YOUR ROUTE KEEPING ON THE ROAD CLIMBING STEEPLY AT FIRST BUT LEVELING OUT YOU WILL COME TO A JUNCTION A HOUSE/BUNGALOW TOGETHER CONTINUE UP THE HILL UNTILL YOU REACH A SIGNPOST WHICH SAY ~~CHAPPLES~~ ^{CHAPPLES}/LOWGILL. KEEP RIGHT PASSING FARM BUILDINGS AND LOW GILL HOUSE CARRY ON FOR A SHORT WHILE ON A TWISTING ROAD;" WHEN YOU COME TO A TRACK ON YOUR LEFT TAKE THIS GOOD BRIDLEPATH THROUGH 3 GATES AND OVER LOWGILL BECK, WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT A T JUNCTION TURN LEFT AND IN ABOUT 400 YDS, WHEN THE PATH LEVELS OUT TURN RIGHT ONTO LONG MOOR WHICH IS VERY WET IN PLACES "YOU WILL SOON BE CLIMBING THE BRACKEN SLOPES ON WINNOW" FROM WINNOW HEAD FOR THE OLD SLATE ROAD WHICH COMES FROM (BURLINGTON SLATE QUARRY OUT OF BOUNDS) "CROSS THIS GOOD PATH WHICH YOU WILL AGAIN CROSS LATER;" WHEN THE MOOR LEVELS OUT YOU WILL BE ABLE TO SEE GRAY CRAGS NOW HEAD STRAIT SLIGHTLY SOUTH EAST TO COCK LAKES SMALL CAIRN HEAV, "FOLLOW A NARROW PATH TO WALL CONTINUE WITH WALL ON YOU LEFT AND DOWN HILL TO THE OLD SLATE RD CROSS A WET BOGGY BIT AND CLIMB UP ONTO GUNSON ^{HIEGHT} ~~HIEGHT~~, FROM GUNSON HIEGHT WALK DUE EAST FOR A SHORT DISTANCE AND PICK UP A GOOD NARROW TRACK BUT VERY WET IN PLACES;" FOLLOW THIS TRACK WHICH CLIMBS SLIGHTLY TO MEET THE WALL. (SHOOTINGHOUSE HILL) C. WOODEN STUMP RIGHT AGAINST THE WALL MARKS THE SUMMIT "NOW THE EASY PART OF THE WALK FOLLOW THE WALL TO PEPPER SWOOD CROSS THE STREAM AND THE MAIN KIRKBYMOOR BRIDLEPATH;" FOLLOW THE FENCE AND CROSS THE FELL ROAD CLIMBING UPHILL WHEN THE PATH LEVELS OUT CONTINUE FOR A SHORT WHILE ALONG THE FENCE TILL YOU CAN SEE THE ^{TRIG} CAIRN ON YOUR RIGHT MAKE A BEE LINE FOR THE SUMMIT (BANKHOUSE MOOR ▲) ON LEAVING THE SUMMIT RETURN TO THE FENCE FOLLOW THIS UNTIL YOU START DECENDING DUE NORTH, "Look North - WESTERLY AND YOU WILL SEE A SIGNPOST HEAD FOR THIS CROSSING THE FELL ROAD AGAIN PASSED S/POST N-WEST ACROSS MOOR AND YOU WILL CROSS GOOD BRIDLEPATH AND UP ONTO (CRAIGHIEGHT) YOUR LAST TOP" FROM HERE HEAD WEST TO BOUNDARY WALL AND FOLLOW IT N-WEST UNTIL YOU PICK UP THE KIRKBYMOOR BRIDLEPATH THIS DECENDS INTO GILLHOUSE BECK SHORT CLIMB OUT TO T JUNCTION AND YOU ARE BACK WHERE YOU STARTED,

SHEET ② The Kirkby moor round AND BURNEY Δ

When reaching GRAY CRAGS REVERT to SHEET
② "A COMPASS BEARING 6° N-EAST to A5092
TRUNK road. Taking the FELL Rd on your right
which SAYS to WOODLAND. (PLEASE BE CAREFUL
ON YOUR APPROACH FROM GRAY CRAGS to the
TRUNK Road old Quarry workings disu.)
"IN ABOUT 400YDS JUST BEFORE WALL ON YOUR
LEFT THERE'S A good PATH which takes you
to the SUMMIT OF BURNEY. Δ "A MAGNIFICENT
VIEWPOINT." RETURN back the SAME WAY CROSS
the TRUNK Rd AND head FOR COCKLAKES your
NEXT TOP.
